

Report of Orientation Program-2022

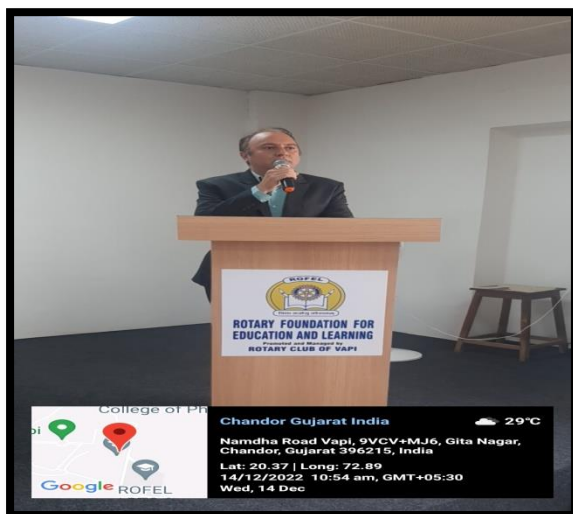
Event: Two days Orientation Program for B Pharm and M Pharm Students

Session 3: Mr Bhavik Jani (Founder Innovative analytical laboratories, Vapi)

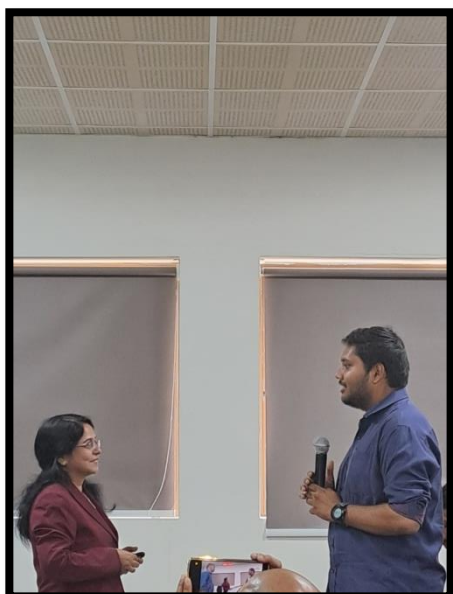

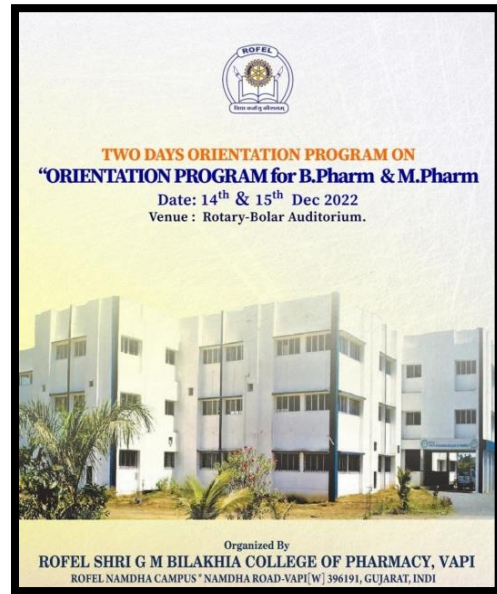
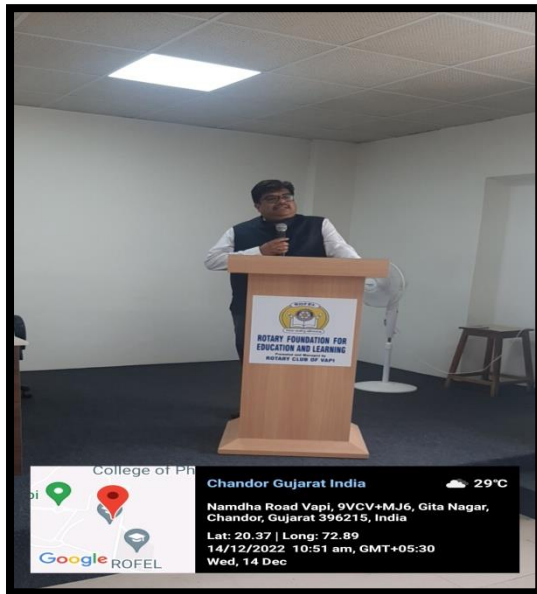
