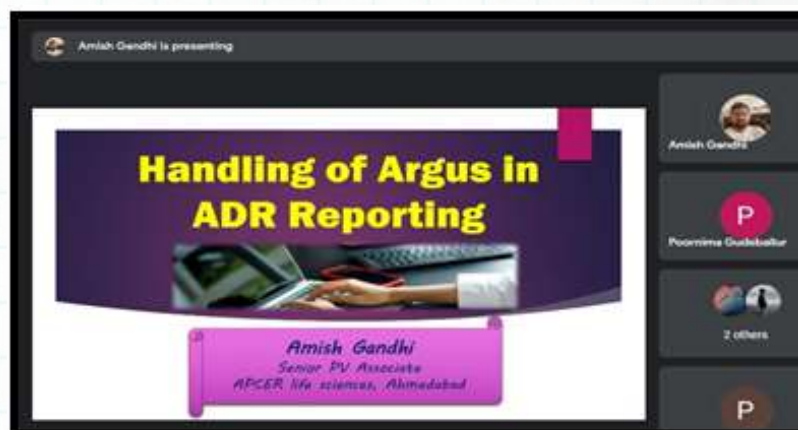
## GTU ZONAL LEVEL EVENT

### NSS ACTIVITY

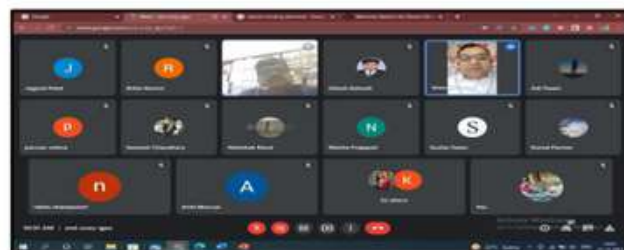
