NSS SPECIAL CAMP

FIRST DAY OF CAMP:

The camp was started with an oath ceremony. On first day a drawing competition was arranged for students of Bhagod Govt. School. Students were encouraged with a small token of prizes. SECOND DAY OF CAMP:

In afternoon, a session was kept for sanitary pads and hygiene. Girls and ladies of village were given importance to use sanitary pads. FIFTH DAY OF CAMP:
