Summary:

Pharmacovigilance plays a pivotal role in ensuring patient safety and improving public health by monitoring, detecting, assessing, and preventing adverse effects or any other drug-related problems. In accordance with the notification issued by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) dated 26th August 2025, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of ROFEL Shri G.M. Bilakhia College of Pharmacy, Vapi organized the 5th National Pharmacovigilance Week Celebration sponsor by Inner Wheel Club of Vapi with the objective of sensitizing students about the significance of pharmacovigilance in clinical practice and healthcare systems.

The week-long celebration, held from 17th September 2025 to 21st September 2025, comprised a series of academic and co-curricular activities including essay writing, poster and slogan competitions, debate and elocution contests, drama competition, an expert webinar, community outreach drive and reel making competition Each event was designed to foster awareness, enhance knowledge, and encourage active participation of pharmacy students in the field of pharmacovigilance.

Day 1 – Essay Writing Competition (17th September 2025)

The celebrations commenced with an **Essay Writing Competition**, aimed at assessing students understanding of pharmacovigilance and encouraging them to express their insights on the subject. Day 6 – Community Outreach Drive on Pharmacovigilance (17th –23rd September 2025)

One of the most impactful highlights of the 5th National Pharmacovigilance Week Celebration was the Community Outreach Drive, conducted from 17th to 23rd September 2025, which aimed to extend the message of pharmacovigilance beyond the institutional boundaries and into real-world healthcare environments. The primary objective of this initiative was to create awareness about Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs), emphasize the importance of ADR reporting, and sensitize the healthcare community and the general public about the pharmacist's pivotal role in ensuring drug safety and improving therapeutic outcomes.
